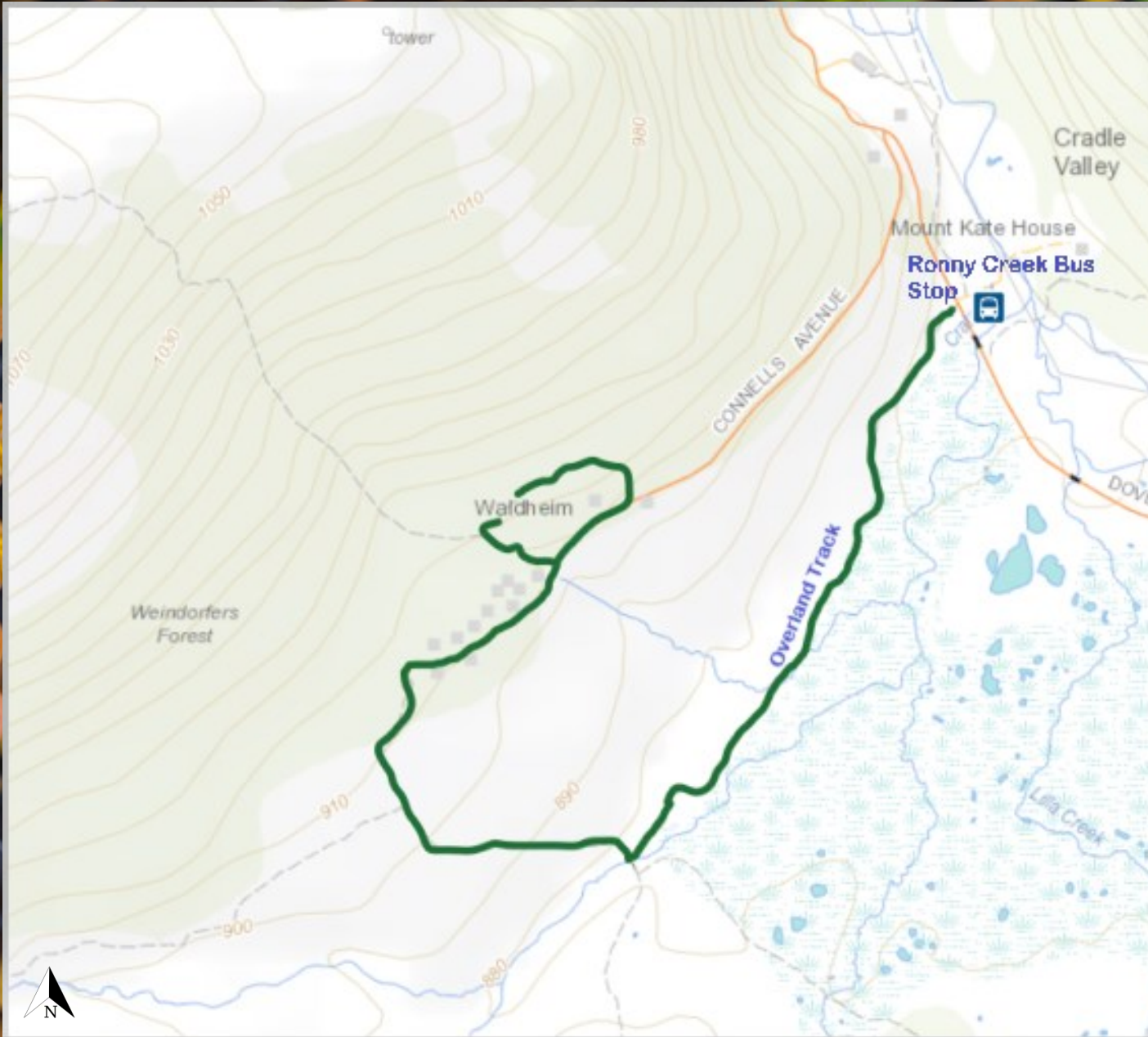
Fagus Trails

Weindorfers Forest Walk

Located next to the historic Waldheim Chalet, Weindorfers Forest Walk is a 20 minute leisurely stroll through ancient rainforest. Some fagus specimens found here are much taller than the more usual stunted alpine form seen at higher elevated areas.

Whilst enjoying the riot of fagus colours that the Waldheim area has to offer, why not take the time to immerse yourself in the rich history of the National Park. Inside Waldheim Chalet is a range of informative displays and narratives of Gustav and Kate Weindorfer; early pioneers who built the guesthouse to share and protect the natural beauty of Cradle Mountain.





Weindorfers Forest Walk

Difficulty Level: Easy

Time: 1 to 1.5 hours return

Starting from Ronny Creek Bus Stop, follow the Overland Track to the first junction.

Turn right onto the narrow boardwalk and continue up a gentle incline to Waldheim Cabins.

Continue to follow the gravel path leading to Waldheim Carpark.

To the right of the historic Waldheim Chalet you will see a fine example of the fagus.

Follow the signs to complete the Weindorfers Forest Walk and head back to Ronny Creek via the same route.
